



# Competency goes digital – leading the charge in credential management

StayLive has partnered with JNCTN to develop an industry-wide, cloud-based competency tool – known as the StayLive Competency Tool (SCT). The SCT is a portable, secure digital record of your competencies and will be accepted across all generation sites and accessible wherever you are.

From 1 July 2025, all contractors and employees in the electricity generation industry will be moving to using the SCT as the new standard to verify training. The Green Passbook is being phased out and will not be accepted after 31 December 2025.





# **SCT BENEFITS**



#### **REAL TIME VERIFICATION**

Ensures that all workers and contractors have the necessary training qualifications and competencies to perform their work safely.



# AUTOMATED CREDENTIAL MANAGEMENT

Streamlines issuing, managing, and verifying credentials, reducing administrative burdens.



#### **ENHANCED SAFETY**

Reduces the risk of accidents by ensuring that qualified individuals only are assigned to specific tasks.



# **OPERATIONAL EFFICIENCY**

Improves overall operational efficiency by ensuring that all personnel are always qualified for their roles.



#### **USER-FRIENDLY INTERFACE**

Provides easy access and management of credentials from anywhere, at any time.



#### **SYSTEM INTEGRATION**

Facilitates easy data synchronisation and avoids duplication by integrating easily with existing systems.



# **ENHANCED DATA SECURITY**

Moving and managing your training information online means stronger security, improved privacy, and reduced risk of loss, theft, or unauthorised access.



#### **COST-EFFECTIVE**

There is an annual subscription cost of \$120 per person for access to the SCT. This should be treated as a standard cost of doing business within the generation industry and incorporated into your annual operating expenses.
